Proclamation by the Queen in Council,

TO THE PRINCES, CHIEFS, AND PEOPLE OF INDIA.

BY THE GRACE OF GOD, OF THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT REITAIN AND IEEE/AND, AND OF THE COLONIES AND DEPENDENCIES THROUGH IS EUROPE, ASIA, AFERCA, AMERICA, AND AUSTRALASIA,

Queen, Defender of the Facth.

Wheras, for three weighty reason, We have readred, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Pempical, and Commons, in Parliment assembled, to take upon Classicov the Government of the Territories in Yangahorostoften administrated in trust for Us by the Hosonamar Earr Lyon, Courage;

Now, therefore, Wa, dir by these Presents motify and docline that, by the infriend seasons afregard, WE have thick upon Oxecletes the said Government, and WE berely will upon all Our Subjects within the said Perenticular to the Saidand, and to bear true Alleginares to Us. Our Heirs and Successors, and to what thinsolves to the abstract; from time to fram, see fit to appoint to administer the Government of Our and Territories, in Our name and Our behalf?

And We, reposing especial trust and comfilience in the logality, ability and judgment of Our right tracty and well-beloved Cousia and Commillion, Caucauss Junes Vencourse Constant on the product than the sold Vencourse Caucaus, to be Our first Vencoury and Gardene Goment in and ones Our said Vencourse Caucaus, no be Our first Vencourse and Gardene in Our name, and penerally to

act in Our name and on Our behalf, subject to such Orders and Remainions as he shall, from time to time, receive from Us through one of Our principus accretaries of singe:

And We do hereby confirm in their several Offices, Civil and Military, all Presums now amplifyed in the Service of the Hostorama Roser INDEX COMPANY, subject in the area officer, placebox, and to such Laws and Regulations as may hereafter be consteld.

The hereby ammence to the Native Princes of India that all Treaties and Ingregionals made with them by or under the suthority of the Horsonana East Inna Contact are by Ta accepted, and will be scrapulously maintained; and Wit and the thirt in the scrapulously maintained;

We dealer no extension of Our present territorial Possessions; and while We will permit no aggression upon Our Dominions or Our Rights to be attempted with impurity. We shall sametion no encreachment on those of others. We shall respect the Eights, Dignity, and Honor of Native Princes as Our own; and We desire that they, as well as Our own Subjects, aloudd only that Possession and the social Advancement which can only be secured by internal Poste and good Government.

We hold Ourselves bound to the Natives of Our Indian Territories by the same Obligations of Duty which bind Us to all Our other Subjects; and those Obligations, by the Blessing of Almourer Gon, We shall faithfully and consciousingly fulfil.

Finally relying Ourselves on the truth of Christianily, and acknowledging with gratified the values of Religion. We dischain allike the Right and the Desire to impose our Convictions on any of Our Subjects. We declare it to be Our Boynl Will and Pleasure that noon be in any wise forced, more molected or dispetited, by senson of that Religious Edith or Observances; but that all shall allike only the equal and importal protection of the Low; and We to strictly charge and exjoin all those who may be in authority under Us, that they abstain from all interference with the Religious Bellef or Wurship of may of Our Subjects, on pain of Our highest Displaceaux.

And it is Our further Will that, so far as may be, Our Schljects, of whatever Base or Creed, he freely tad importially admitted to Offices in Our Service, the Duties of which they may be qualified, by their education, ability, and integrily, duly to discharge.

We know, and respect, the feelings of attachment with which the Natires of Isrna vagard the Lands inherited by them from their Anoeston; and We desire to protect them in all Rights connected theoretis, subject to the equilable demands of the State; and We will that presently, in framing and administering the Law, due regard be paid to the ancient Rights, Usages, and Customs of Iwra.

We deeply lament the ords and misery which have been brought upon Isota by the acts of ambitions Men, who have deceived their Countrymes by false reports, and led them into open Rebellion. Our Power has been shown by the Suppression of that Rebellion is the field; We desire to show our Mercy, by parsing the Offences of those who have been thus misled, but who desire to return to the path of Duty.

Already in one Province, with a view to stop the further effusion of blood, and to husten the Pacification of Our Indian Dominious, Our Viceory and Governor General has belt out the expectation of Parlion, on certain terms, to the great

majority of those who, in the late unhappy Disturbances, have been guilty of Offences against our Government, and has declared the Funishment which will be inflicted on those whose Crimos place them beyond the reach of Forgiveness. We approve and construct the said act of Our Viorovy and Governor General, and do further sumounce and proclaim as follows:—

Our Clemency will be extended to all Offenders, new and except those who have been, or shall be, convicted of having directly taken part in the Murder of Beritish Subjects. With regard to such, the demands of Justice forbid the creeking of Mercy.

To those who have willingly given anylum to Murderers, knowing them to be such, or who may have seeds as Leadure or Instigators in Revolt, their Lives alone can be guaranteed; but in apportioning the Femalty due to such Ferson, full to consideration will be given to the eigenmetances under which they have been induced to throw off their Albegiunce, and large indulgence will be shown to those whose Crimes may appear to have originated in too uncolaious acceptance of the false reports circulated by designing Men.

To all others in Arms against the Government, We hereby promise unousditional Pardon, Amnesty, and Oblivion of all Offence against Ourselves, Our Crown and Dignity, on their return to their homes and peaceful pursuits.

It is Our Royal Pleasure that those Terms of Grace and Amnesty should be extended to all those who comply with their Conditions before the First Day of January next.

When, by the Blessing of Paortuneus, internal Tranquillity shall be restored, it is Our current Desire to stimulate the peaceful Industry of Ivrus, to premote Works of Public Utility and Improvement, and to attainistic its Government for the beaudit of all Our Subjects resident therein.
