1762 ————— **1890: British Government** ← → **Manipur State**
 [127 Years] - Friendly relationship between two sovereign States.
 - Anglo Manipuri Treaty signed.

1891 ————— **1947: Crown** ← → **Manipur State**
 [14 April 30 June] - Declared war between British and Manipuri.
 [55 Years] - Manipur defeated in the War: Anglo Manipuri War of 1891.
 - British conquered Manipur but Manipur did not annex to the British Empire by the British Government.
 - Manipur State forfeited to the Crown.
 - Established political relation between the Crown and Manipur State.
 - Manipur State was ruled by native Prince under the crown paramountcy and suzerainty. And remained as a State with internal sovereignty.

1946 0000: - Manipur State excluded from India by Order in Council by His Majesty in Council.

1947 ————— **1947: INDIA** ← → **MANIPUR State**
 [1 July 14 August] [45 days] | [Empire of India] Contracting State Contracting State
 - Political relation between two sovereign States by bilateral agreement
 Agreement made between His Majesty [Monarch] - His Highness [Monarch]
 - Sharing of external sovereignty of the Manipur State with India.
 - Political arrangement made by British under a political policy based on Cabinet Mission Memorandum.

1947 ————— **1950: INDIA** ← → **MANIPUR State**
 [15 August 25 January] [2.5 Years] | [Empire of India] Contracting State Contracting State
 - Governor of Assam has executive authority jurisdiction to excluded area or State.

1950 ————— **2018: INDIA** ← → **MANIPUR State**
 [26 January December] [66 Years] | [Union of India] Contracting State - Successor State Contracting State
 Monarchic State

1950 2018: Indian Union
 [26 January 2018] - India - Dominion of India - **Union of India**
 - **INDIA** shall be a **Union of India** Republic State
 Indian - Negotiating State [Article 260: Jurisdiction]
 - Extra-constitutional relation.
 - Political relation between two sovereign States by bilateral agreement.
 - Sharing external sovereignty of Manipur State with India
 - Political relation between Manipur State and India as Contracting State, and Union of India as negotiating State.
 - India has external sovereignty. Union of India is a part of India.

1 July and 2 July 1947 Agreement: It is an international political agreement made between two Sovereign States under the "Common Supreme Authority", His Majesty while Crown paramountcy was in operation in Manipur and in India. This Agreement is perpetual and irrevocable.
