THE INDIA (ADAPTATION OF EXISTING INDIAN LAN ORDER, 1947

Whereas sub-section (3) of section 18 of the Indian Inde dence Act, 1947 (hereafter in the recitals to this Order referred of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of a Central as "the said Act") provides that save as otherwise expressly provi in the said Act, the law of British India and of the several p. 3. AND WHEREAS sub-section (1) of section 9 of the said Act the Dominion of India. vides that the Governor-General shall by order make such provin (2) Without prejudice to the general effect of the preceding as appears to him to be necessary or expedient for bringing lagraph, references in any existing Indian law to "the whole of provisions of the said Act into effective operation and for remova difficulties arising in connection with the transition to the provisi of the said Act;

Now THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred by said Act, the Governor-General is pleased to make the follow

- 1. (I) This Order may be cited as the India (Adaptation Existing Indian Laws) Order, 1947.
- (2) It shall come into force on the fifteenth day of Aug 1947.

- (2) The General Clauses Act, 1897, applies for the interpreta-
